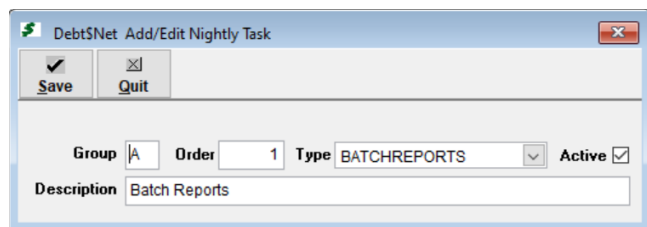


Prestige 23 Free Features Spotlight

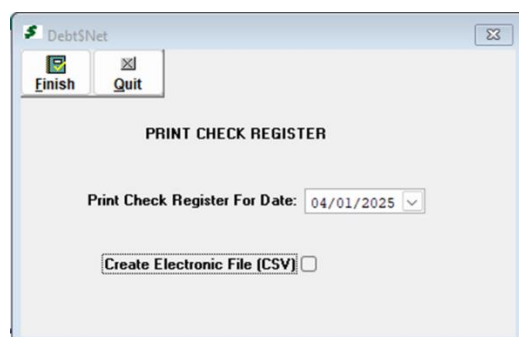
Nightly Process Module
